Problem Statement

- WG Chair position:
 - should not be a life sentence
- WG might need some new blood
- No procedure for selecting a new chair

Questions and Answers

- How many chairs?
 - 3 chairs (RIPE-542)
- Rotation period?
 - 3 years (1 chair/year)
- How to add, change, remove a chair?

New Chair Selection Process

- Chair announce the end of the term by sending email to the mailing list
 - 1 month before the autumn meeting
 - Chair may or may not resign in this announcement
- Request for volunteers
- If too many candidates:
 - They try to sort it out themselves prior to the meeting
 - If there is no consensus: voting?

 - voting?
