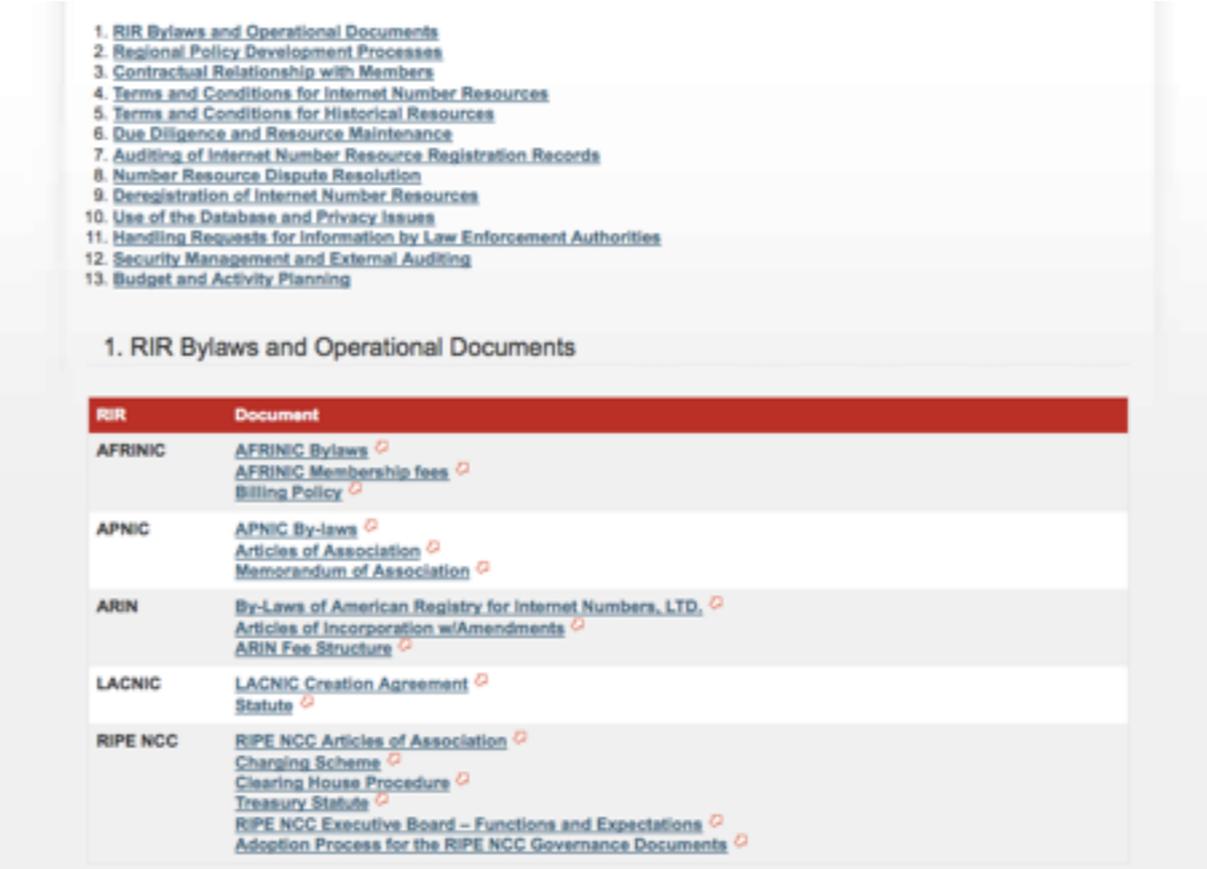

- Compliance with what the community wants
  - Open, inclusive, transparent, bottom up Policy Development Process
  - Constant communication with the community
- Operational accountability
  - Membership-based organisation
  - Elected Board - responsive to what membership wants
  - Governance documents for transparency and reference
- Continuing evolving framework
- Similar for all RIRs

- This is our achievement - not a given for all organisations
  - ICANN meeting in London, IGF in Istanbul
    - Various questions around ICANN's accountability
    - Distrust - impression that Board is not accountable
    - Other organisations under scrutiny
- Need to defend our system
  - Communicate to the rest of the world how our accountability works
  - Documentation in a collective and comparable way for all RIRs

*...but disagreements*

*Essential aspect of the transition!!*

*Finally:*

*Part of ICANN's accountability indeed related to the transition and other parts are broader*

Creation of Accountability Cross Community Working Group (CCWG)

- Draft Charter
  - The RIPE NCC (as ASO representative) in the Drafting Team
- Two Work Streams
  - **Work Stream 1** - accountability issued that can be:
    - solved before the IANA transition or
    - identified as relevant to the IANA transition to be solved later
  - **Work Stream 2** - broader accountability issues
  - **Out of Scope:** Accountability issues of RIRs
- Participants (2-5) from each SO, AC and individuals
- Charter to be circulated
